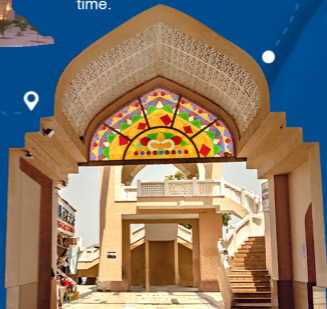
### 1 Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque

This iconic monument welcomes visitors of all religions and hosts upto 20,000 worshippers at a time.

## Wadi Shab



### 1 Bimmah Sinkhole

Locals believe that the sinkhole was caused by a meteorite and have named it Hawiyat Najm which means 'the deep well of the (falling) star'.

A stunning gorge showcasing a deep canyon, glistening pools, a waterfall in the caves and white-rock walls.



### 3 Exploring Wadi Shab

Explore this 2-hr trail by hiking through canyons and swimming through emerald pools, hidden caves and magnificent rock walls.

### 4 Mausoleum of Bibi Maryam, Qalhat

Captured by the Portuguese in 1507, this is the single standing witness to Qalhat's glory, dating back to 8th-14th century.

## Sur



### 1 Ras Al Jinz Turtle Reserve

Located in the easternmost tip of the Arabian peninsula, this is a well-known nesting site for endangered green sea turtles.

### 2 Al Ajjah Lighthouse

A historic lighthouse on the hills overlooking the Arabian Sea that assures a cinematic view of the coastal city of Sur.

### 3 Al Ajyah Fort

A uniformly square-shaped fort built on the perimeters of merchant houses and their elaborately carved doors and lotus-pillared porches.

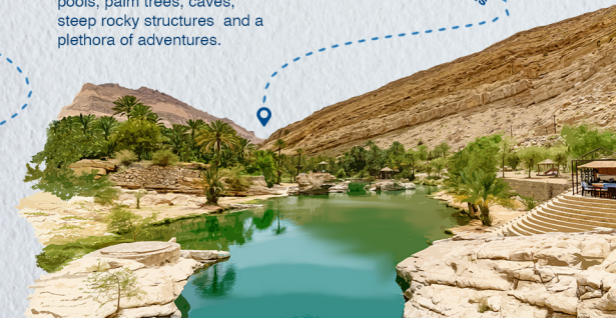

### 3 Traditional Omani Meals and Coffee

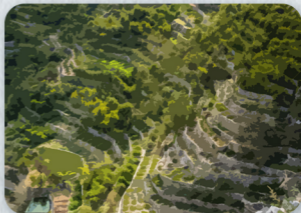
Flavourful ubhar, shuwa, camel curry and sweet treats await you for a hearty meal at Delicious Omani Meal at Bald Sayt.
